Pastor's Newsletter

It is incredible how quickly the year has passed. Now, the leaves, in the colors of the fall season, are showing how glorious our Creator was when He fashioned the earth. Now, the Thanksgiving and Christmas season is even more quickly approaching. It is the season of giving and receiving, a time to think about those who are less fortunate and those who have lost a lifetime of building homes that would feel a sense of joy around the Christmas season. The Bible teaches that giving and receiving are acts of worship and gratitude to God, who is the greatest giver of all. The Bible also promises that whoever gives generously and faithfully will be blessed and refreshed by God, who will repay them for what they do.

When it comes to lending a helping hand to those in need, the pages of the Bible provide profound wisdom, reminding us of our duty to support and uplift our fellow human beings. Read these words from Matthew 25:35. "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty, and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger, and you invited me in.:" A challenging verse for us to consider in the quest to actively seek out opportunities to help those who are less fortunate, showing them the love and care of Christ through practical acts of kindness.

On the evening of December 15th, we will sponsor a hurricane relief benefit concert, supporting a community outside of Asheville, North Carolina, where Hurricane Helene cut bridges in half, took homes, vehicles, and appliances, and glued them to riverbanks and trees. People are already exhausted, losing wages, and small business owners are losing their dreams. All one has to do is read the news on the scale and cost of recovery. There are more than 7,000 locations with road damage, including 654 bridges. Many of the counties that have received an outpouring of donations from water to food to clothing are now asking for donors to shift to financial support. It becomes easy to forget the tragedies of the world, especially when out of sight becomes out of mind. However, as the body of Christ, we should not forget that tragedies such as the one from Hurricane Helene will take years before any semblance of life returns. This is where we come in. So, why this community? Easy. One of our sister ECO churches has ties to this community, and to which supplies have already been collected and sent in recent days.

So, what can you do? Plenty! Support the benefit. Volunteer to bake cookies or serve hot chocolate. Volunteer to give someone who doesn't drive at night a ride. Volunteer to be a greeter. Volunteer to be outside to answer questions. Volunteer to invite people to Christmas Eve. I think you get the message! It's not for us but for the glory of God. We have much to be thankful for in this season of giving and receiving! Look for the postcards and flyers soon. God bless you all during this season! Pastor Gary

HELP SUPPORT THE BULADEAN COMMUNITY CENTER NEAR ASHEVILLE, NC




